



Elementary Spanish Teacher (Part-Time)

PRINCIPAL ROLE OF SPANISH TEACHER:

- Instruct students in the Spanish language to work toward proficiency in writing, speaking, listening
- Collaborate on major assessments with fellow teachers using the STREAM curriculum
- Provide individual and small group instruction to adapt the curriculum to the needs of students with varying abilities and background
- Integrate both language skills and cultural literacy
- Plan highly engaging lessons using authentic activities to help children internalize language components such as its basic lexicon and grammatical structures
- Prepare classes using formal, written lesson plans
- Evaluate student work and maintain up-to-date records of student assessments and grades
- Maintain a pleasant and productive class environment that is student-centered and conducive to learning
- Participate in professional development opportunities when available
- Perform other duties as assigned

EDUCATION:

- A minimum of a BA in Spanish, Teaching or Education, or a related field is required.

EXPERIENCE:

- Experience teaching, preferably with elementary children, with a demonstrated interest in and knowledge of the Spanish language
- Must have native or near-native proficiency in the Spanish language
- Experience with integrating appropriate educational technologies into the teaching environment as needed

SKILLS:

- Ability to communicate effectively through speech and writing
- Ability and willingness to plan and organize materials, lessons, and assessments
- Ability to work with colleagues at the school to develop collaborative STREAM lesson plans write assessments, and generally maintain academic standards
- Flexibility in dealing with changing schedules and situations
- Must be supportive of teaching students in a Catholic School
